Reminders from Our School Nurse:



An End-of-the-Year Reminder from the School Nurse about Medication and Vaccines:

If your child has medication at school, please pick up the medication on their last day of school (Friday, May 25th for most of the school, but the date varies for Pre-K, Kindergarten, 8th and 12th grade) **Medication must be picked up by a parent as students are not allowed to transport medication.**

Any medication that is not retrieved by parents will be discarded.

School medication orders are only valid for the current school year. New medication orders from your child's physician will need to be completed for the 2018/2019 school year. If your child has a life-threatening health condition and you indicate this on his/her paperwork, a medication & emergency action plan form will be mailed to you in the summer so that you can have them filled out and signed by your child's physician before school begins. You can then bring them into school (along with your child's medication) before school begins or on the first day. Please remember that your child **CANNOT** begin school without these items in the school nurse's possession if they have a life-threatening health condition (asthma, diabetes, peanut/tree nut allergy, other serious food allergies, heart condition, epilepsy/seizures, bee sting allergy, etc.).

School Vaccine Requirements for 2018-2019

*****VARICELLA: NEW Chickenpox Requirement:**

All children in **PRE-K** need **1 DOSE** of vaccine – parental documentation of disease is **NO LONGER ACCEPTABLE** – Healthcare provider verified child had disease is acceptable

*****All children attending Kindergarten THROUGH 12th GRADE need 2 DOSES of vaccine – parental documentation of disease is NO LONGER ACCEPTABLE - Healthcare provider verified child had disease is acceptable. (***this is a new requirement as of 2016/17 school year – ALL students [including high schoolers] are REQUIRED to have 2 DOSES of the Varicella vaccine***)**

Tdap Reminder:

Proof of Tdap vaccination is REQUIRED of children who are attending 6th thru 12th grades and/or are 11 years of age.

DTaP/DT/Td/Tdap: 4 doses for Pre-K, 5 doses for Kindergarten thru 12th grades, plus the Tdap requirement described above for 6th thru 12th grades.

Polio (IPV or OPV): 3 doses for Pre-K, 4 doses for Kindergarten thru 12th grades (3 doses if 3rd dose is given after 4th birthday).

MMR: 1 dose for Pre-K, 2 doses for Kindergarten thru 12th grades.

Hepatitis B Reminder: 3 Dose Requirement:

3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine administered at appropriate ages and intervals are now required for students attending **Pre-K through 12th grade** (2 doses acceptable on an accelerated schedule for 11 to 15 year olds if they have not received the vaccine – talk with their doctor please).
