The Clark County Health Department recently came to FFCS to do an inspection of the kitchen and asked if students use the microwave in the kitchen. Because of state health regulations and requirements, students are not allowed to come into the kitchen during the time that food is being served. Unfortunately, this means they are no longer allowed to utilize the microwave in the kitchen area, which means there is only one microwave available to use during their lunch time. Because of the circuits allocated to the lunch room and kitchen, we cannot add another microwave, as it would blow the circuit.
