3 & 4 Year Old Academics: These students meet twice a week. They focus on learning their ABCs, letter recognition, and letter sounds, as well as number recognition, counting, and the beginning of the concept of one-to-one correspondence.

4 & 5 Year Old Academics: Meeting three times a week, this program has a stronger focus on the academic skills needed to prepare students for success in the academically high kindergarten program at FFCS. Their phonics focus includes letter recognition, letter sounds, and beginning blending. They also work on number concepts and science.

Uniforms
